East Middle School 7th Grade Music Cedar Point Trip

Dear Parents,

We are looking forward to our annual 7th grade music Cedar Point Trip! This year's trip is **Friday**, **May 29th** and is open to 7th graders at East Middle School in band, choir, or orchestra. We also need chaperones!

The day includes a music clinic at Bowling Green University with expert clinicians in band, choir, and orchestra. After our clinic, we will spend the rest of the day at Cedar Point. We will leave East Middle School very early in the morning and return late at night.

You must register for the trip and pay online at http://portal.brightsparktravel.com/. Go to "register for a tour" and use the code T58UF2V when prompted. The cost of the trip is \$130%, divided into two payments. The first payment is \$50 due on February 24th, and the second payment is \$80 due March 27th. The trip price includes round trip transportation aboard first class, air-conditioned, DVD equipped motorcoaches, music clinics, Cedar Point admission, T-Shirt, planning, and liability insurance. Brightspark is the tour company organizing our trip.

We'd love if you could join us as a chaperone! The chaperone price is also \$130, and the registration process is the same as for students. Chaperone duties include riding the bus, checking in with your attendance group, assisting directors, helping organize students, and helping with student needs. Chaperones will also be asked to complete a one hour shift at our group's meeting spot.

Student Eligibility Requirements

The East Middle School Music Department plans trips to provide musical and educational experiences for our students and to reward them for quality effort and performance throughout the year. Unexcused absences from required performances or rehearsals or inappropriate classroom and rehearsal behavior may be reasons for exclusion from the trip.

Eligible Students Will:

- Receive no more than a total of 3 "1" (Little or no mastery) or "0" (Rarely mastery) grades in citizenship on all progress reports and report cards in ALL classes. (When you receive your 4th "1" or "0" you are no longer eligible.
- Have no Level 2 behavior-related suspensions (in or out of school).
- Receive a passing grade in their performing art class on their report card

This policy is important. It forewarns students that there are consequences for improper behavior by trip participants. If a student becomes ineligible to attend this trip, there is a possibility of lost monies.
